OAKE MANOR GOLF CLUB - Local Rules

- 1. OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 27)**
A Ball is Out of Bounds if it lies:
(a) Beyond any centre of hedge, fence or watercourse forming a boundary to the course.
(b) On or over the driveway behind the 9th and to the right of the 10th hole. Beyond white posts running along the left side of the 9th hole. (this OOB does not apply to hole 10). Beyond white posts on both sides of hole 11.
(c) Beyond the fence forming a boundary to the driving range - relief may not be obtained from the fence, only under penalty.
(d) 18th hole - the storage lagoon, car park and on or over paving, brickwork and paths surrounding the clubhouse.
(e) The road between the 13th and 14th holes.
(f) 5th hole - out of bounds over the watercourse between the 5th and 15th holes.
(g) The house and gardens and the turf nursery between the 13th and 17th holes.
(h) Beyond the inside line at ground level of any line of white posts forming a boundary.
- 2. WATER HAZARDS (Rule 25)**
(1) Water hazards are identified by yellow stakes.
(2) Lateral water hazards are identified by red stakes.
- 3. INTEGRAL COURSE FEATURES**
Relief may not be obtained from the 1/2 way house and safety netposts on the 9th hole or timber surrounds in bunkers (e.g. 15th hole).
- 4. STONES IN BUNKERS (Rule 25-1)**
Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions. (Rule 24-1) applies.
- 5. GROUND UNDER REPAIR (Rule 25-1)**
Clear tractor/vehicle marks and sunken drainage runs through the green. - G.U.R. areas will be so marked or identified on the main clubhouse notice board.
Any newly laid or seeded area so marked.
- 6. STAKED TREES**
If a young tree identified by a stake, rabbit guard or tag interferes with a player's stance on the

- area of his intended swing, the ball MUST be lifted, without penalty, and dropped in accordance with the procedure prescribed in Rule 24-2(b). The ball may be cleaned when so lifted.
- 7. IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (Relief may be taken under Rule 24-2)**
(i) Man-made paths, steps, bridges, pylons/cables and shrubby areas, including their surrounds. The fenced area between the 15th & 17th holes; free drop from the nearest dropping zone.
(ii) Course furniture, ball washers, sprinkler heads and covers.
 - 8. CROQUET LAWN 11TH HOLE (Rule 24-2)**
Any ball landing on this area MUST be dropped off, without penalty, not nearer the hole.
 - 9. PLUGGED BALLS (Rule 25-2)**
A ball may be lifted from its own pitch mark in the rough or fairway, cleaned, and dropped without penalty.
- PENALTY FOR BREACH OF LOCAL RULES**
Matchplay - Loss of hole. Strokeplay - 2 strokes
- SLOW PLAY** - Please keep up with the match ahead - slower matches must let faster games through. Two balls have priority over other matches when the course ahead is clear.
- NOTE - Fields adjacent to the Golf Course are strictly out of bounds - it is trespassing to enter land over the boundaries of the Course to recover lost balls. Balls may only be retrieved from water hazards during the course of play - it is not permitted to return to recover golf balls after play is completed.**
- NOTE - Driving range balls are company property. We will prosecute any theft or use of balls outside the confines of the Driving Range - offenders will be banned from Oake Manor.**
- Oake Manor Golf Club Limited do not accept any liability for damageless of property, or personal injury while on the club premises or using Oake Manor facilities. Vehicles parked or driven through the golf course do so at their own risk.
